F. PRE-TOURNAMENT COACHES MEETING

The Pre-Tournament coaches meeting will occur in the Hospitality Room, just outside of gym, immediately following weigh-ins. Please have a representative present for the meeting. You will conduct some WSWCA business and request members there to vote.

G. WEIGH-INS

- **All athletes will need Photo ID for weigh-ins.** All wrestlers are to be present and remain in the designated weigh-in ahead during the weigh-in period – this will be strictly followed. During the weigh-in process, no activities that promote hydration or dehydration will be allowed.

- Please inform your students and parents ahead of time so they come prepared to pay admission.
- Only wrestlers in uniform, participating in the tournament, will be admitted free entrance. Wrestlers will be expected to pay if not participating in the tournament.
- Press passes will be accepted with proper identification. Only those photographers approved by the Tournament Manager will be permitted on the gym floor.
- WIAA “All Access”, “Limited Access” and “Lifetime” passes will be accepted.
- WSCA and WSSAAA passes will be accepted.
- LEAGUE PASSES will NOT be accepted.

I. AWARDS & PICTURES

1. Awards will be given to the top FOUR place finishers in each weight class.
2. Individual awards will be presented during each group of matches in the championship round. Once done with awards, the top four finishers in each weight class will move to photo area to have their group picture taken for the state program. **Per WIAA policy, wrestlers need to be dressed in school warm-ups, which include a top and bottom.** Athletes will not be allowed to be in street clothes or have hats, sunglasses, mascots or any other items in the picture with them.
3. Team scores will be kept but there is not a team trophy for this first round of the state tournament.

J. STATE QUALIFIERS

1. The top FOUR place finishers in each weight division will qualify for the State Wrestling Tournament to be held in the Tacoma Dome, February 17-18, 2023.
2. The 5th place finisher will become the alternate at the State Tournament. The alternate will be used in the event of a scratch by a higher placer.

K. OFFICIALS

L. DISPUTES

1. Any disputes occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Director and they will confer with the Tournament Committee present. Their decision will be final.
2. The WIAA expulsion rule (23.32-Conduct eligibility rules and penalties) will be followed.

M. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Locker Rooms – both locker rooms will be available to use.
 - a. Wrestlers deposit all garbage in trash cans.
 - b. Bulletin boards are left untouched and PE lockers are not disturbed.
 - c. Coaches should discuss proper care of locker room area.
 - d. Locker rooms are for athletes only and off limits to families and fans.
 - e. Anacortes High School is not responsible for any lost or stolen items and athletes are encouraged to not leave valuables in the locker room area.
2. Each school must furnish their own towels.
3. Floor restrictions
 - a. No one will be permitted to stand along the mats, including coaches, wrestlers, and spectators.
 - b. The limit is **two coaches** per mat. Violations will be reported to the tournament director and the head coach will be notified.
4. Parking

Parking is available north and south of the gym and on-street parking.
Busses should park in the bus loop area on the southwest corner of the high school off of 20th street.

5. Signs

No signs except official school banners allowed.
6. Band and noisemakers

No bands or noisemakers will be allowed.

N. SPECIAL INTRODUCTION BEFORE CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND

This procedure will be reviewed at the coaches meeting February 11th. The championships will be held on three mats.

O. TEAM SCORING

1. All tournament scoring will be as stated in the National Federation Rule Book (Rule 9, Section 2)

TEAM PLACEMENT

First Place – 16 points	Fourth Place – 7 points
Second Place – 12 points	Fifth Place – 5 points
Third Place – 9 points	Sixth Place – 3 points

2. TOURNAMENT SCORING

Individual placement points shall be awarded as soon as earned. Placement points already earned will be deducted in case of forfeit (other than injury) or disqualification from the tournament. Points for team scoring shall be awarded as follows:

- a. Two (2) team advancement points shall be scored for each match won in the championship bracket, except for the final first place match. If a wrestler receives a bye in the first round, he shall be awarded 2 advancement points for that round if he wins his next match.
- b. One (1) team advancement point shall be scored for each match won in the consolation round, except for the final third and fifth place matches. A wrestler who has a bye in the consolations round shall receive one advancement point, provided he wins the next round match.

3. POINTS FOR DEFAULT, DISQUALIFICATION, FALL, OR FORFEIT

- a. Two (2) additional points will be scored for each match won by default, disqualification, fall or forfeit throughout the tournament.
- b. One (1) and one-half (1/2) points will be awarded for each match won by a technical fall.
- c. One (1) point will be awarded for each match won by a major decision.
- d. Automatic pin points will be awarded if two teammates meet at any point in the tournament.

4. OTHER SCORING

In tournament scoring six places, the winner of each championship quarterfinals shall be awarded three points, and the winner of each championship final shall be awarded for additional place points. The winner of the quarterfinal consolation match shall receive three additional place points. The winner of the third place and the winner of the fifth place shall receive two additional place points.

P. WITHDRAWAL OF QUALIFIERS
