Weigh In

Will be in the auxiliary gym. Athletes will be weighed by weight class on three scales. Wrestlers must provide identification and any skin irregularities/disease must be accompanied by the state approved skin lesion medical release from and signed by a physician stating the earliest date of return to competition. All Wrestlers must be in the weigh-in room, and remain until weigh-ins are complete. No activities that promote hydration or dehydration will be allowed during the weigh-in process.

Mats: three mats will be used through the consolation semis rounds. Two mats will be used for the final. Two mats will be in the main Sam Benn Gymnasium and one mat will be in the Auxiliary Gym.

Officials: Assigned by the WOA

Floor Access: Limited to two school representatives and four cheerleaders for each match NO EXCEPTIONS. If a team exceeds this limit, a warning will be given, then an unsportsmanlike team penalty may be assessed, resulting in a loss of team points. During respective matches, team video will be permitted from designated mat side locations.

Bleachers: Bleachers on the west side of the Gym will be reserved for Wrestlers and coaches. Bleachers on the east side are for fans and paid attendees.

Warm up area: Space on the wrestlers side of the mat will be available for warming up.

Blood Clean up: Paper towels, disinfectant bottles will be available at a central location near each mat.

Medical: A licensed trainer, Trinity Pariss, will be available for the entirety of the tournament.

Team Seating: Teams will be allowed to sit in the west side bleachers. An option for eating will be the commons down the stairs in the front of the gym.

Hospitality Room: NO KIDS/STUDENTS/WRESTLERS/CHEERLEADERS ALLOWED! Please remember to clean up after eating.

State Photos: Photographs of the top 4 placers will be taken in the auxiliary gym immediately after the presentation of each weight class award. Please assist us in getting your athletes to the auxiliary gym for their photo! School warm up tops (zippered or buttoned) and bottoms are required attire for photo session (NO HATS IN PICTURES)

- Four (4) coaches passes
- One (1) trainer pass
- Two (2) student manager passes
- Press Pass, WIAA Lifetime Pass, WSSAAA Pass, and WSCA Passes
- No School or District passes accepted

Cheerleaders: Cheerleaders from participating school in uniform will be admitted free of charge. A cheer coach must be present. No more than 4 cheerleaders will be allowed on the mat at any time. One cheer supervisory pass per team.

Valuables: Each team is responsible for their own valuables.

Towels: Each team must provide its own towels.

Programs: Programs will not be available. The bracket may be followed on Trackwrestling.com

T-shirts etc: Rush Team Apparel will be on site, offering a variety of state clothing.

Bus Parking: Bus parking is available on the side of the school on G Street. Van parking available in the parking lot across the street from the Gymnasium.
