- 7:00 am Doors will open for teams to arrive. Locker rooms and check scales are available.
- 7:55 am All participants must be in the weigh-in area by 7:55 am. Line-up by weight class on the mats.
- 8:00 am Weigh-in will be started by *weight class*. **Picture ID is required for all wrestlers.**
- 9:00 am Coaches meeting – head coaches.

8:45 am Doors open to spectators.

Pass Gate Lists: AD's need to submit pass gate lists **before 3:00pm on Thursday, February 9.** (info coming)

Passes: Four coaches, two managers, and one student video, photo, and journalism representative (school authorized credentials) are admitted at no charge but their names must be on the pass gate list. Only WIAA authorized passes, WSCA (WA Coaches Association) passes and WSSAAA (WA athletic director association) passes will be honored.
School district and league passes will NOT be accepted.

Signage: No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

Buses: After dropping off wrestlers at the gym, all buses must park in the parking areas **INDICATED ON THE ATTACHED MAP** at Todd Beamer High School. Do not park in the TBHS gym parking lot.

Qualifiers: The top **FIVE (5)** wrestlers advancing to the WIAA Mat Classic XXXVIII at the Tacoma Dome on February 17-18, 2023. The sixth-place finisher will be the Region 2 alternate to state. We will wrestle to 8th place in the event another alternate is necessary. Schools are not required to bring 7th or 8th place finishers to Mat Classic unless notified they are the first alternate or entered in the tournament.

Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.

Awards: Medals awarded to the top five placers in each weight class.
 All wrestlers will wear their school warm-ups on the podium.
 NO HATS, HOODS, OR HEAD PHONES ON THE PODIUM OR FOR WIAA STATE PROGRAM PHOTOS
 No team awards presented

Bracketing: With two sub-regions qualifying six wrestlers each to this regional, the bracket will be the same for each weight class. The bracket will be flipped top-to-bottom every-other weight, though they are the same.

The letter is the qualifying tournament designation; the number is the qualifying tournament placing.
 Example Sub A #1 is the Sub-Regional A #1 place finisher
