Tournament Schedule for Saturday, February 11, 2023

- 7:00 am Doors will open for teams to arrive. Locker rooms and check scales are available.
- 7:55 am All participants must be in the weigh-in area by 7:55 am. Line up by weight class on the mats.
- 8:00 am Weigh-in will be started by *weight class*.
- 8:45 am Coaches meeting – head coaches.
- 8:45 am Doors open to spectators.**
- 9:30 am **Anticipated schedule** (will progress without breaks).
 - 9:30 am Pigtail matches
 - 10:00 am – 11:45 pm Round 1, championship bracket
 - 11:45 pm – 1:30 pm Championship semi-finals and Consolation 1
 - 1:30 pm - 2:30 pm Consolation semi-finals
 - 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm Third and fifth-place matches
 - 3:30 pm – 5:30 pm Championship finals and awards

Weigh-In: Weigh-in will be completed by weight class. **Picture ID is required for all wrestlers.**

Mats: Four mats will be used for most of the tournament. Two matches for the placing matches.

Pass Gate Lists: AD's/Coaches need to submit pass gate lists via **email** to the tournament director **before 3:00 pm on Thursday, February 9.**

Passes: Four coaches, two managers, and one student video, photo, and newspaper representative (school-authorized credentials) are admitted at no charge but their names must be on the pass gate list. Only WIAA-authorized passes, WSCA (WA Coaches Association) passes and WSSAAA (WA athletic director association) passes will be honored.

The school district and league passes will NOT be accepted.

Signage: No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

Buses: After dropping off wrestlers at the gym, all buses must park South of the BGHS Main Gym. Do not park in the general public parking lots.

Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.

Qualifiers: The top **FOUR (4)** wrestlers advancing to the WIAA Mat Classic XXXIII at the Tacoma Dome on February 17-18, 2023. The fifth-place finisher will be the Region 3 alternate to state.

Awards: Medals awarded to the top four placers in each weight class.

All wrestlers will wear their school warm-ups on the podium.

Bracketing: With two sub-regions qualifying four wrestlers each for this regional, the bracket will be the same for each weight class. The bracket will be flipped top-to-bottom for every weight, though they are the same.

The letter is the qualifying tournament designation; the number is the tournament placing.

Example Sub A #1 is the Sub-Regional A #1 place finisher

Locker Rooms: Use of the boy's locker rooms will be available. Each team and individual are responsible for their own valuables. Battle Ground HS is not responsible for your valuables – lock them up or keep them with you.

Trainer: An athletic trainer will be on site.

Games Committee: Any disputes occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Manager who will confer with the Games Committee. Their decision will be final. The WIAA expulsion rule (23.32 – Conduct eligibility rules and penalties) will be followed.

The Tournament Games Committee will consist of at least three of the following:

- Head Official
- Tournament Manager or Assistant
- Coach from a neutral school
- WIAA representative by phone
